The Diocesan requirement to receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion is two years of preparation, beginning in first grade. <u>The Sacrament of First Reconciliation</u> is celebrated in the 2nd grade. <u>The Sacrament of First Holy Communion</u> will be celebrated in the 3rd grade. The requirement to receive First Reconciliation is completion of first and second grade Religious Education.

The requirements to receive First Holy Communion are reception of First Reconciliation and completion of second and third grade Religious Education.

<u>The Sacrament of Confirmation</u> is celebrated in 9th grade. The Diocesan requirement is completion of 7th and 8th grade Religious Education.

Baptism – Please call the Rectory office to set up a Baptism – 203-268-5838, Monday thru Thursdays – 9:00am to 3:30pm. A Pre-Baptism class is required for both parents prior to the Baptism of their 1st child

John was standing with two of his disciples and as he watched Jesus walk by he said. 'Behold the Lamb of God.' The two disciples heard what he said and followed Jesus. He said to them, 'Come and you will see.'




