

Dear Friends,

As the summer heat sets in, I am glad to be working towards the in-person reopening of Caroline House to our women and children in September (Please God). In these unprecedented times where we have lost loved ones, including our former Board Chair Sister Grace D'Amico, we are grateful that our lives are slowly returning to normal.

During these tough times, with the support and direction of our teachers, our students have pivoted to virtual ESL classes. We have also been blessed to have our tutors work remotely with some of our school-aged children, while Jean Fredricks and friends have been working with our preschoolers. They have done an amazing job and we cannot wait to see what the next school year holds!

As we work on a safe reopening of our in-person classes, I feel a special urgency to restart an enhanced afterschool program for children from the second to the eight grades. All students have lost a lot during this year, especially in reading skills, but this is especially true for the children of immigrants who are not fluent English speakers. If they do not learn to read, their future will be bleak!!!

We need your help to continue moving forward. Like many other non-profits in the wake of the pandemic, we have experienced a concerning drop in revenue due in part to our inability to host all of our fundraising events, and many of our long-time donors were unable to provide their regular support. Through it all, we have continued to deliver services and the expenses, including salaries, building upkeep, and materials, have remained the same.

Today I am asking you to please SUPPORT OUR ANNUAL APPEAL to ensure that our Fall and Winter months will be funded, and we can continue to provide excellent ESL classes and support our students and their families.
