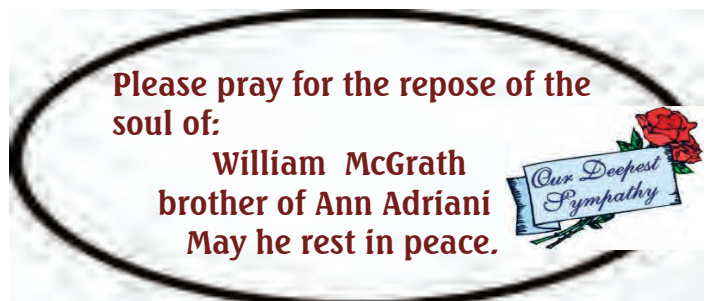
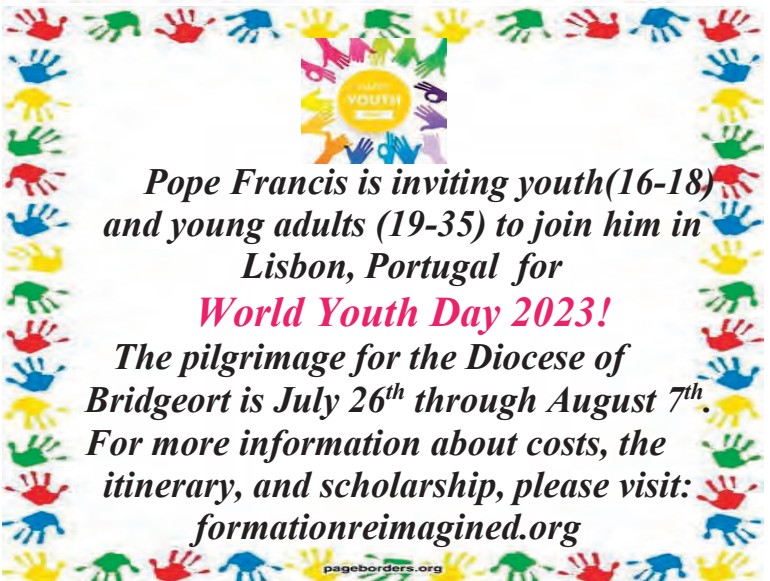

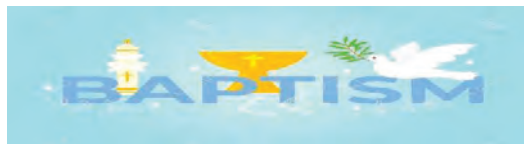
The Pantry can always use:

at least 1 Godparent to be able to get a sponsor

letter/form from their church stating that
they are a parishioner in good standing.

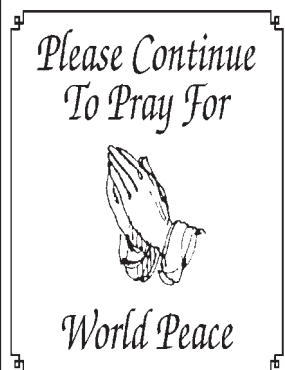
