Completed Registration Forms were due July 1st, 2020. The grace period was extended from the original due date until JULY 15th, 2020





Twenty-fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time September 20, 2020


"Seek the Lord while he may be found, call him while he is near. Let the scoundrel forsake his way and the wicked his thoughts, let him turn to the Lord for mercy, to our God who is generous in forgiving... What if I wish to give the last the same as you? Or am I not free to do as I wish with my own money? Are you envious because I am generous?"

Last week, the scriptures focused on forgiveness and the sin of anger. Today another capital sin, envy, provides food for thought. How often the expression 'I don't get mad, I just get even' is spoken.
