

SPECIAL REQUEST


They have asked for travel size toiletries so that the volunteers can make up bags for the clients!

As you know the cost of food has risen so much. Anything you can do is **GREATLY** appreciated!









Jesus said "Peace Be With You". Jesus wants us to feel peace within our hearts. He also asks us to forgive others.
