

tuna, pasta sauce, peanut butter, canned vegetables, beans,(black, kidney, etc., mac and cheese – also toilet paper and soap.

As an afterthought - Diapers (can be open boxes - left over from your children), baby wipes are always needed.

Twenty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time August 30, 2020

"I say to myself, I will not mention him, I will speak in his name no more. But then it becomes like fire burning in my heart, imprisoned in my bones; I grow weary holding it in. I cannot endure it... Do not conform yourselves to this age but be transformed by the renewal of your mind that you may discern what is the will of God, what is good, pleasing and perfect."

Recently some friends told me that they have an agreement, to speak with others about Jesus and their relationship with Him. One person found it exciting, as the person was so receptive to learn of her joy in revealing her story. The second, found it more difficult, as the person resisted, but she was convinced something good had happened.
