


The Pantry can always use:

<u>Please take note</u>: It is a requirement for at least 1 Godparent to be able to get a sponsor certificate from the Church that they are registered in. A Sponsor Certificate is a letter/form from their church stating that they are a parishioner in good standing.

<u>Sponsor Certificates:</u> We <u>CANNOT</u> give you a *Sponsor Eligibility Certificate* unless you are a <u>registered member of the parish</u> for at least 6 months and attend Mass

regularly.
