

The requirement to receive First Reconciliation is completion of first and second grade Religious Education.

The requirements to receive First Holy Communion are reception of First Reconciliation and completion of second and third grade Religious Education.

The Sacrament of Confirmation
_is celebrated in 9th grade. The Diocesan
requirement is completion of 7th and 8th
grade Religious Education.

A Pre-Baptism class is required for both parents prior to the Baptism of their 1st child



Our Lenten Sacrifices

<u>Days of Abstinence</u>: Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday for all who have reached their 14th birthday, no meat can be taken.

<u>Days of Fast:</u> Ash Wednesday and Good Friday for all who have reached their 18th birthday and have not as yet reached their 60th birthday, a limit of one full meatless meal.


Weekdays of Lent: No Obligation to fast, however, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

<u>Easter Duty Obligation:</u> Must be made from the First Sunday in Lent through Trinity Sunday.

<u>Self Denial:</u> is encouraged on a voluntary basis. Acts may include daily Mass, spiritual study, Lenten Devotions, the Rosary, Stations of the Cross and deeds of mercy and kindness.

<u>Eucharistic Fast:</u> 1 hour from foods and liquids. Water and medicine never break the fast.
