Lenten Regulations 2022

<u>Fast</u>: limit of one full meal on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday for Catholics between the ages of 18 & 59 inclusive. <u>Abstinence</u>: All Fridays during lent are Days of Abstinence. Catholics from the age of 14 and above are asked to abstain from meat on all the Fridays during Lent.
