The Diocesan requirement to receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion is two years of in-class preparation, beginning in first grade.

The Sacrament of First Reonciliation is celebrated in 2nd grade. The Sacrament of First Holy Education Communion is celebrated in 3rd grade. The requirement for receiving First Reonciliation is completion of first and second grade Religious.

The requirements for receiving First Holy Communion are receiption of First Reconciliation and completion of second and third grade Religious Education.

The Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated in 9th Grade. The Diocesan requirement is completion of 7th and 8th grade Religious Education in class.

Home schooling is not available.

All Church offices will be closed on Monday September 4th in observance of Labor Day.


The Pantry can always use:

As you know the cost of food has risen so much. Anything you can do is **GREATLY** appreciated!







TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Jeremiah 20:7-9

In this particularly poetic passage, Jeremiah complains that while teaching the Lord's word, he is subjected to insults and derision. He determines to remain silent, but he cannot because the desire to speak the Lord's name is "like a fire burning in my heart."

Second Reading: Romans 12:1-2

Paul tells the Christians to make sacrifices to avoid the trappings of the times, and to do God's will.

Gospel: Matthew 16:21-27

Jesus tries to make his disciples realize that by following him, they will endure suffering, degradation, and death. He tells them that they must deny themselves and take up the cross in order to be his disciples.



A FRESH PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS


Twenty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time September 3, 2023

"I urge you brothers and sisters, by the mercies of God, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God, your spiritual worship. Do not conform yourselves to this age, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that you may discern what is the will of God, what is good, pleasing and perfect."
