\*Weekdays of Lent: No Obligation to fast, however, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

\*Easter Duty Obligation: Must be made from the First Sunday in Lent through Trinity Sunday (See the schedule for Reconciliation Monday)

\*Self Denial: is encouraged on a voluntary basis. Acts may include daily Mass, spiritual study, Lenten Devotions, the Rosary, Stations of the Cross and deeds of mercy and kindness.

\*Eucharistic Fast: 1 hour from foods and liquids. Water and medicine may be taken at any time.
