

Blessed Sacrament Food Pantry Each month, the Women of Notre Dame collects items for the Blessed Sacrament Food Pantry in Bridgeport. The items requested are needed the most, as determined by the pantry's director. At last month's Women of Notre Dame annual Lenten Luncheon, two volunteers from the Blessed Sacrament Food Pantry spoke to us about daily operations at the pantry, who uses it, how grateful they are to receive our donations, and how rewarding it is to volunteer there. Over 300 registered families use the Food Pantry. In addition to food, the Blessed Sacrament Food Pantry provides toiletries, clothing, and small household goods.

The items needed most each month are listed in the ND parish bulletin along with the dates of collection. *In May, we are collecting donations the weekend of May 4 and 5;* the pantry needs toilet paper, bar soap (not Ivory), jars of spaghetti sauce, and cans of fruit, meats (like Spam), and Chef Boyardee. ### <u>Easter Sunday</u> <u>The Resurrection of the Lord</u> <u>April 21, 2019</u>
