The Diocesan requirement to receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion is two years of preparation, beginning in first grade. <u>The Sacrament of First Reconciliation is</u> celebrated in the 2nd grade. <u>The Sacrament of First Holy Communion</u> will be celebrated in the 3rd grade. The requirement to receive First Reconciliation is completion of first and second grade Religious Education.

The requirements to receive First Holy Communion are reception of First Reconciliation and completion of second and third grade Religious Education.

The Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated in 9th grade. The Diocesan **requirement** is completion of 7th and 8th grade Religious Education.

His daddy's name was Joseph, And Mary was His mam, This babe was very special He was God's only Son,


Some angels came from heaven, And they began to sing. To the shepherds in the fields below, "Glad tidings do we bring!"


A bright star lit the heavens, To light the magi's way. To the baby in the manger Who was born on Christmas day.
