

#### **Our Lenten Sacrifices**

<u>Days of Abstinence</u>: all Fridays in Lent, for all who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday, no meat can be taken.

<u>Days of Fast:</u> for all who have reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday and have not as yet reached their 60<sup>th</sup> birthday, a limit of one full meatless meal.

Weekdays of Lent: No Obligation to fast, however, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

<u>Easter Duty Obligation:</u> Must be made from the First Sunday in Lent through Trinity Sunday.

<u>Self Denial:</u> is encouraged on a voluntary basis. Acts may include daily Mass, spiritual study, Lenten Devotions, the Rosary, Stations of the Cross and deeds of mercy and kindness.

<u>Eucharistic Fast:</u> 1 hour from foods and liquids.

Water and medicine never break the fast.

# Loaves and Fishes Collection Through Sunday, April 4th

Fasting during the Lenten season is one of several penitential practices that is part of our Catholic tradition. Voluntary fasting from food creates in us a greater openness to God's spirit and deepens our compassion for others. As you fast during

Lent, please consider dropping your spare change into the Loaves and Fishes collection jars located in the vestibule of the church if you are coming to the stations or coming into the Church to pray, and near the elevator if you are coming to Mass.

Together we can enhance our Lenten fasting practice by giving up meals and donating the cost of those meals. If you prefer, you can drop a check into the jar or mail it to the Rectory; please make checks payable to Notre Dame of Easton with "Loaves and Fishes" in the memo.

Education.

The Sacrament of Confirmation
\_is celebrated in 9th grade. The Diocesan
requirement is completion of 7th and 8th
grade Religious Education.

"Jesus answered and said to her, 'If you knew the gift of God and who is saying to you, 'Give me a drink', you would have asked him and he would have given you living water... Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again but whoever drinks the water I shall give will never thirst. The water I shall give will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life."

Do yourself a favor. Open your bible to chapter 4 of John's gospel and live the scene of Jesus and the Samaritan woman. Discover the gentle invitation of Jesus, opening her heart to what He wanted for her.

Loving God,


