# **Our Lenten Sacrifices**

<u>Days of Abstinence</u>: Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday for all who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday, no meat can be taken.

<u>Days of Fast:</u> Ash Wednesday and Good Friday for all who have reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday and have not as yet reached their 60<sup>th</sup> birthday, a limit of one full meatless meal.

<u>Weekdays of Lent:</u> No Obligation to fast, however, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

Easter Duty Obligation: Must be made from the First Sunday in Lent through Trinity Sunday

Self Denial: is encouraged on a voluntary basis. Acts may include daily Mass, spiritual study, Lenten Devotions, the Rosary, Stations of the Cross and deeds of mercy and kindness.

**Eucharistic Fast:** 1 hour from foods and liquids. Water and medicine never break the fast.
