Ministry to the Homebound





The Parish requirements for the receipt of First Holy Communion are receipt of First Reconciliation and completion of second and third grade Religious Education.

The Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated in 9th grade. The Parish requirement is completion of 7th and 8th grade Religious Education in class. Home schooling is not available

<u>Sponsor Certificates</u>: We <u>cannot</u> give you a sponsor certificate unless you are a <u>registered</u> <u>member of the parish for at least 6 months</u> and attend Mass regularly. If Father does not know you personally or by sight, the only other way of knowing you are a practicing Catholic is by tracking your contributions by check or envelope.

<u>Baptism</u>: The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12 noon. A Pre-Baptism class is required for both parents prior in the Baptism of their 1<sup>st</sup> child. Register by calling the Parish Office: 203-268-5838.

<u>Marriage</u>: Weddings are generally celebrated on Friday evening or Saturday afternoon. They must be scheduled at least 1 year in advance. *Please do not make final arrangements for your reception prior to contacting the Parish Office.*
