Dear Faithful and Generous Friends.

We all know that, for safety, we should try to keep our social distance. But the clients of our food pantry simply cannot resist the temptation to linger awhile after collecting their groceries. Mostly, they are sharing the creative ways that they are combining the items in their bags: the stew can be served over noodles, the vegetables and beans can be added to soup, the canned chicken can go in the canned chili with another can of beans. The raisins can be softened and added to the fruit cocktail!

For a brief moment, everything looks and feels normal. God bless you and thank you for your gift of \$1,000 and your donated groceries. Just last week we distributed 249 bags estimated to be valued at \$70-\$80. They are heavy and tax our volunteers to their limits as they keep the supply of pre-packed bags constant. And yet, from within the safety of our parish house, I hear only laughter and normal conversation. There is joy in their being able to provide food for the hungry. God bless you and thank you for that brief moment of joy!

Like most of our parishes, we struggle with the logistics of coming together again to worship.

Meanwhile we are almost ready to plan our garden!

There is relief in doing what is necessary and normal for this time of year at Blessed Sacrament. This year we will sow primarily okra and callaloo (a Jamaican greens) to offer in our neighborhood pop-up market.

Our prayer for you, faithful and generous friends, is that you be blessed with those brief but vital moments when life feels "normal" again. May God bless you and protect you until those moments return to stay.
