
- \* For anointing of the sick please call the office so Father Lyons can visit.

Twenty-eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time October 11, 2020

"I know how to live in humble circumstances; I know also how to live with abundance... I have learned the secret of being well fed and of going hungry, of living in abundance and of being in need. I can do all things in him who strengthens me. Still, it was kind of you to share in my distress. My God will fully supply whatever you need, in accord with his glorious riches in Christ Jesus."
