I hope that everyone enjoyed their summer, which ended this past Monday, as we all know. I hope that you were able to rest and relax a bit, to get away and spend time with your family and friends. It's so important that we take some time to do that because a change of venue or a respite from the usual routine does refresh and renew us.

We were able to get a few things accomplished during the summer months that will hopefully enhance the buildings and property. We installed 5 new replacement windows in the hall, which completes that project. Each window cost \$4,500 to replace, since they have to be custom made. The new windows certainly make the hall a bit brighter, which is positive. The portico over the front door of the rectory, which was replaced last summer, was painted to finish off that project. The rectory was power-washed and all of the 57 shutters painted, which helps give the building a fresh, new look. The maple tree, located along the rectory driveway, is diseased and needs to come down. We noticed the disease last year and attempted to save it, but the remedy did not work. We have the tree men scheduled to do that in the next week, depending on their schedule.

We are in the process of getting a quote to have the transoms in the church replaced, as well as a quote to have the walkway by the two side doors replaced, but based on time, those projects may be deferred until next year. In any event, we are making progress and moving forward.

I am grateful to those who use the monthly "Capital Campaign" envelope on a regular basis. It is that income that helps accomplish projects like those just mentioned. Costs such as those, should not be paid from the "operating account", which is intended for the day to day expenses of running the parish, meaning the weekly and monthly bills.

Last Sunday we enjoyed our parish picnic and it was a beautiful day, and the weather couldn't have co-operated better. For those unable to attend, we missed your company. My thanks to the Picnic Committee and Crew as well as the Boy Scouts and their parents who all helped make for a wonderful afternoon. We are most grateful and appreciate their time and effort.

As we move into autumn, we ask God's continued blessings for our parish family, as well as the intercession of our Patroness, the Blessed Mother.
