Ministry to the Homebound



The Women of Notre Dame Annual Membership envelope is in the newest set of envelopes. Membership dues is \$20 for the year, \$10 for seniors.



This is very important!!! It was brought to our attention by a parishioner that they were "texted" by Fr. Lyons asking for gift cards! It was NOT TRUE! THIS IS WHAT PROMPTED US TO SEND THIS WARNING TO YOU.

Internet thieves are preying on people who use iTunes gift cards and cashing them in for billions of dollars. You might get a text or e-mail that looks like it is from someone you know asking you to buy an iTunes gift card. THIS IS A SCAM — criminals are selling the codes for a fraction of the retail price and cashing in. The FBI calls this a "confidence fraud romance crime", and said they receive more than 800 complaints a day. Consumers lost more than \$1.3 billion in 2016. If you get a text or an email from someone asking you to buy an iTunes gift card, IGNORE IT. Last year, the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) received more than 7,000 complaints about scammers using prepaid cards like iTunes gift cards.
