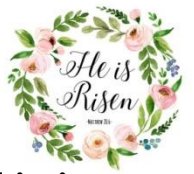

### 2020-2021 REGISTRATION:

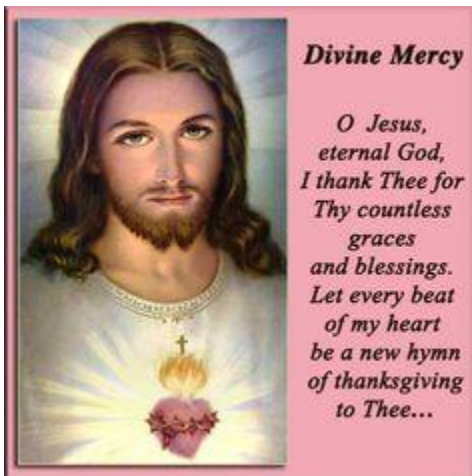
