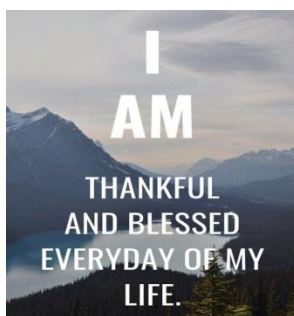
Registrations received in our office after September 1st are subject to a \$75.00 per child late fee.

This is very important!!! It was brought to our attention **by a parishioner** that they were "texted" **by Fr. Lyons** asking for gift cards! It was **NOT TRUE! THIS IS WHAT PROMPTED US TO SEND THIS WARNING TO YOU.**

Internet thieves are preying on people who use iTunes gift cards and cashing them in for billions of dollars. You might get a text or e-mail that looks like it is from someone you know asking you to buy an iTunes gift card. **THIS IS A SCAM** — criminals are selling the codes for a fraction of the retail price and cashing in. The FBI call this a "confidence fraud romance crime" and said it receives more than 800 complaints a day. Consumers lost more than \$1.3 billion in 2016. **If you get a text or an e-mail from someone asking you to buy an iTunes gift card, IGNORE IT.** Last year, the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) received more than 7,000 complaints about scammers using prepaid cards like iTunes gift cards.
