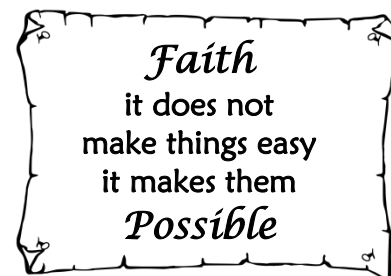

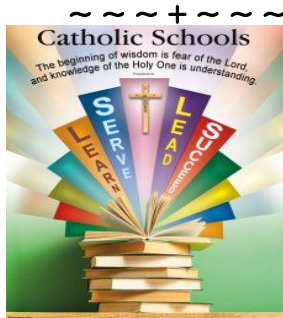




## All are Welcome!
