### Remembering Loved Ones Lost to Cancer



St. Vincent's SWIM Across the Sound cancer charity is sponsoring the 21st Annual Memorial Service on Sunday, August 5 at 8:30AM at Captain's Cove Seaport in Bridgeport. Registration begins at 8:00am. The event is free of charge, and open to all members of the community who have lost a loved one to cancer regardless of hospital affiliation.

The service provides an opportunity for families and friends to heal after the loss of loved ones, and to acknowledge the importance and contribution of every life. Highlighting the service will be the reading of names of deceased loved ones submitted by participants, followed by the symbolic scattering of sunflowers, representing each person and the glory of life, onto Long Island Sound. The service will also include prayer, musical tributes by bagpiper P. Thomas Landry, the "Just Voices Chorus," and a soloist, inspirational readings by St. Vincent's leadership and oncology staff, an honor guard from the Knights of Columbus and a symbolic candle-lighting ceremony.

Refreshments will be served after the service, which runs no longer than one hour and will be held rain or shine. The facility is handicapped accessible.

The Sacrament of First Reconciliation is celebrated in the 2nd grade. The Sacrament of First Holy Communion will be celebrated in the 3rd grade. The requirement for reception of First Reconciliation is completion of first and second grade Religious Education.

The requirements for the reception of First Holy Communion are reception of First Reconciliation and completion of second and third grade Religious Education. The Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated in 9th grade. The Diocesan requirement is completion of 7th and 8th grade Religious Education in class. Home schooling is not available.

Sponsor Certificates: We cannot give you a sponsor certificate unless you are a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass regularly. If Father does not know you personally, or by sight, the only other way of knowing you are a practicing Catholic is by tracking your contributions by check or envelope.

Baptism – The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12 noon. A *Pre-Baptism Class* is required for both parents prior in the Baptism of their 1<sup>st</sup> child. Register by calling the Parish Office: 203-268-5838
