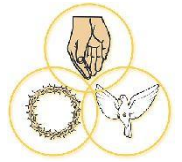

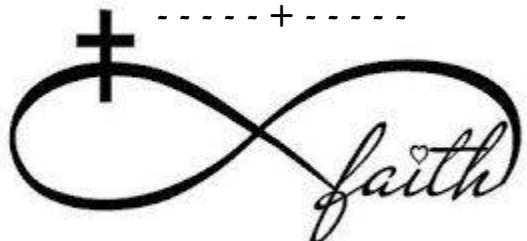

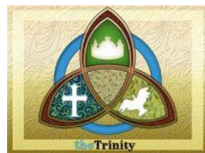

## The Most Holy Trinity June 7, 2020
