Please bring donations to the kitchen in Church.

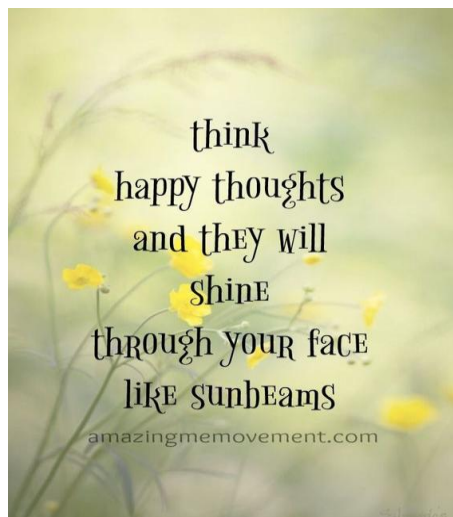
