Expired or unused medications can be disposed of on Saturday, October 27th, 9am-1pm at the parking lot of the Easton Public Library.

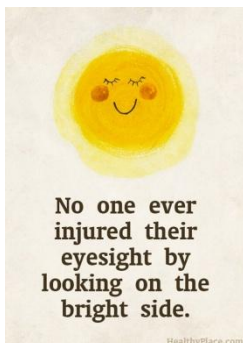

second and third grade Religious Education.

is celebrated in 9th grade. The Diocesan
requirement is completion of 7th and 8th
grade Religious Education in class.
Home schooling is not available.
