Autumn Day of Recollection

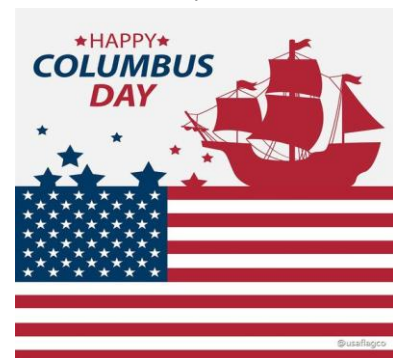
